Our Sailing programmes.

At Sailability Auckland we have a sailing programme suitable for everyone regardless of their level of disability or sailing skills. Our yachts have many safety features including a weighted center board ensuring the boats are virtually impossible to capsize. We provide life jackets and have a hoist available to help people in and out of boats if needed. We operate from two locations within Westhaven Marina.

We are confident that we offer the safest way for you to develop your potential to enjoy sailing as a sport. Sailors who have been trained by our instructors are now competing at sailing events around the world and two have qualified NZ for the Paralympics in the SKUD 18. Others just enjoy the freedom that sailing gives them.
