



Dear Athlete

Please find attached the criteria to be eligible for a 2012 PNZ Shooting Performance Enhancement Grant (PEG). The criteria has been developed through the assessment of thirteen events including the Beijing 2008 Paralympics, the IPC 2010 Shooting World Championships and eight World Cups. Athletes will be required to meet the **Qualifying score** and the **Total score** at the 2011 IPC Shooting World Cup in Sydney to be eligible for a PEG. Athletes currently receiving an Elite PEG who do not meet the 2012 PEG criteria will have the opportunity to present their case to the PNZ High Performance Director to retain elite PEG status.

Due to the nature of PEG's investment from High Performance Sport New Zealand to Paralympics New Zealand (PNZ) the sum of each level PEG will not be known until late December.
